St. Stephen's students come from 25 Texas cities, nine states and 13 countries. Approximately 30 percent of our domestic students are people of color, and 19 percent of our students come from outside the United States. By interacting with classmates from other cultures and backgrounds both inside and outside the classroom, our students learn to see the world through the lenses of others. This helps them develop a deeper understanding of the challenges and opportunities facing our world along with a stronger connection to others and commitment to service.

At the same time, St. Stephen's cultivates a safe, supportive environment where students become the best version of themselves by learning to take risks, make mistakes and grow from their experiences as members of a loving community.

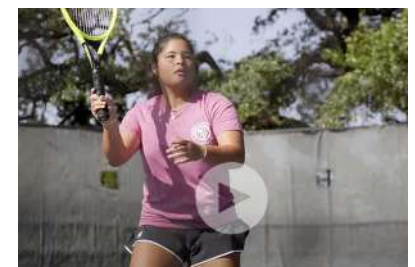
